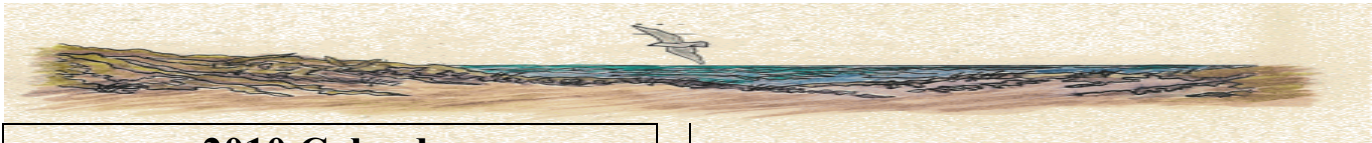
## **Women Needed...**

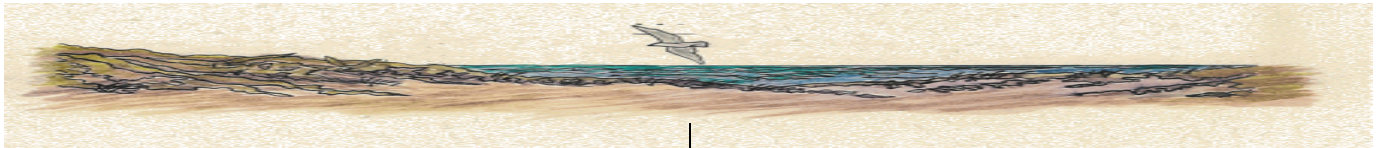

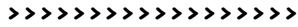
