Rediscover-Recommit Workshop Success On August, 17th, 22 members of our community and 7 members of the Secretariat (elected members of the governing board) met at Zion, Ferguson to examine who we are as the River's Edge Via de Cristo Community and where God is calling us to go. Dick and Loretta Volker, from Princeton, IL were our able facilitators. Discussion at each table was lively as we worked together to discover our strengths and identify areas that need tending so that we may continue to be a vibrant community of believers living out God's promises in our 4th Day Journeys. Each attendee had the opportunity to identify three action steps that we should consider. The three general areas identified are 1) the community (reconnecting the members who have attended weekends, growing into new churches and expanding clergy participation), 2) improving communication, and 3) training.

We can't be together without enjoying the fellowship of Christian friends and, of course, food goes with fellowship! We thank Elizabeth Evans and Gail Voss for organizing the lunch and thank all who brought beverages to share. A generous free will offering helped cover the cost of lunch.

Evaluations from the community indicated the day was well spent. When we are together for Ultreyas and for weekends our agenda is planned. The Rediscover-Recommit Workshop gave us the opportunity to talk about topics such as leadership training outside of the weekends, communication, sponsorship, reaching out to other churches and more.
